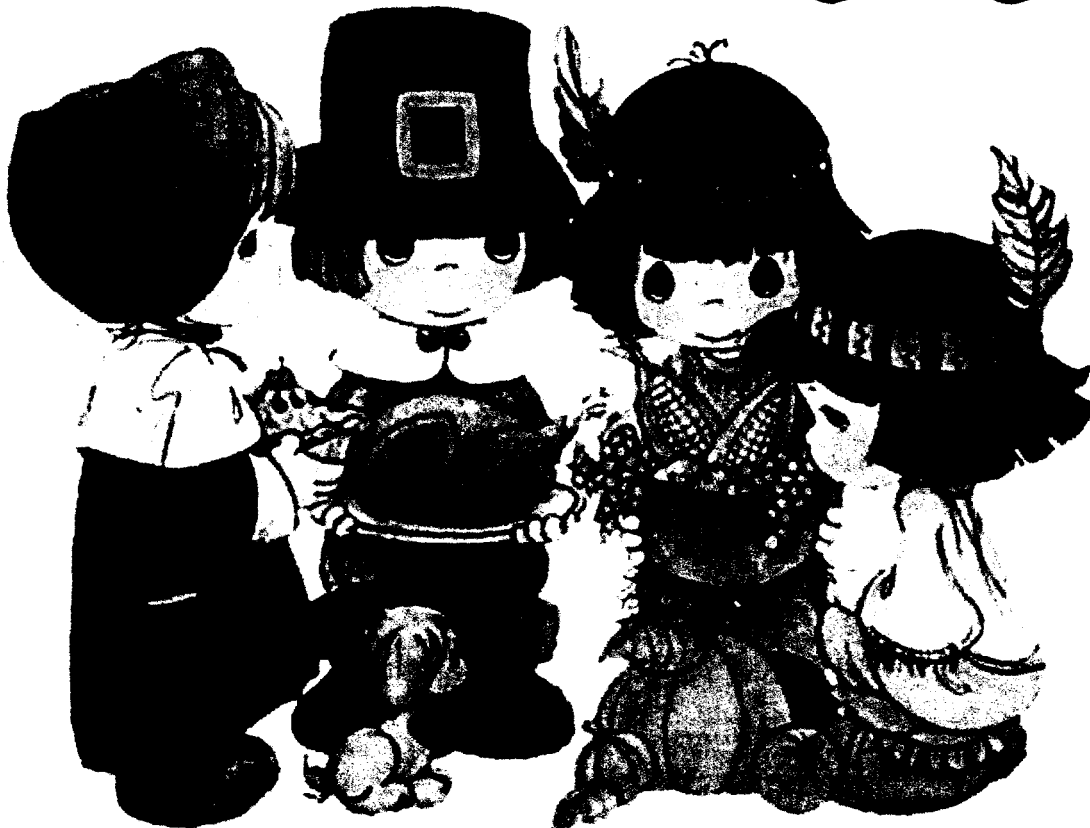

United Methodist Men

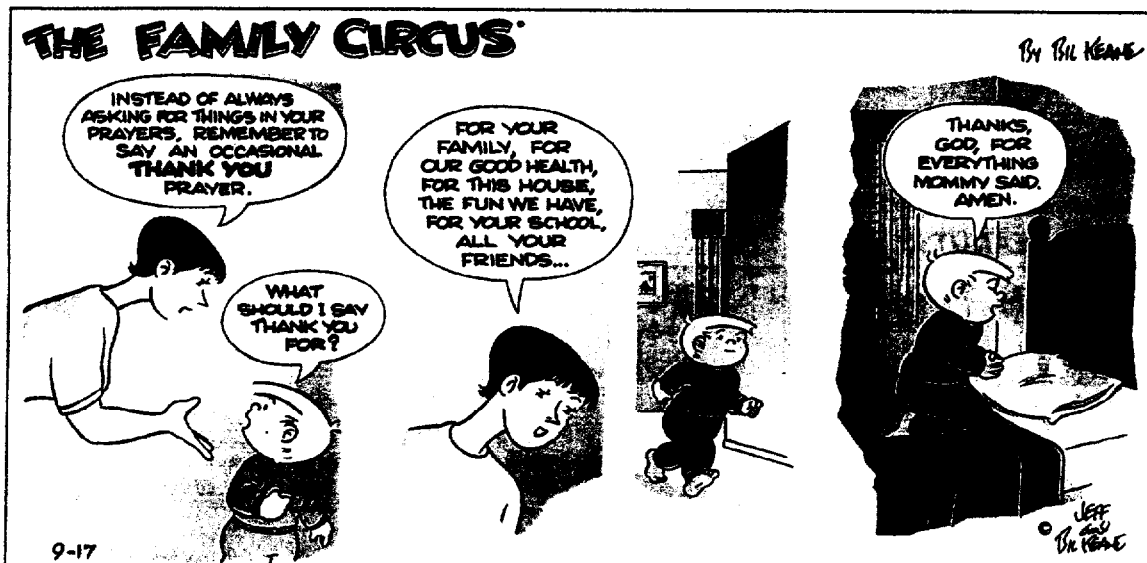

Humpty Dumpty will be closed November 23rd and 24th for Thanksgiving break. The center will reopen Monday, November 27th.

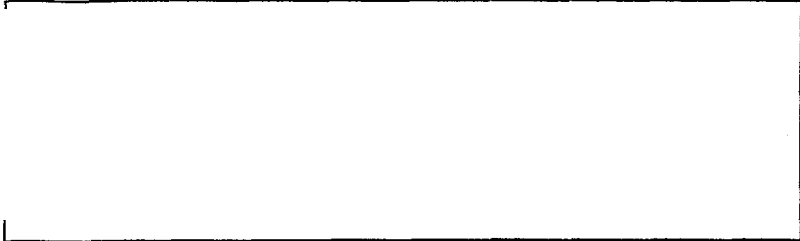

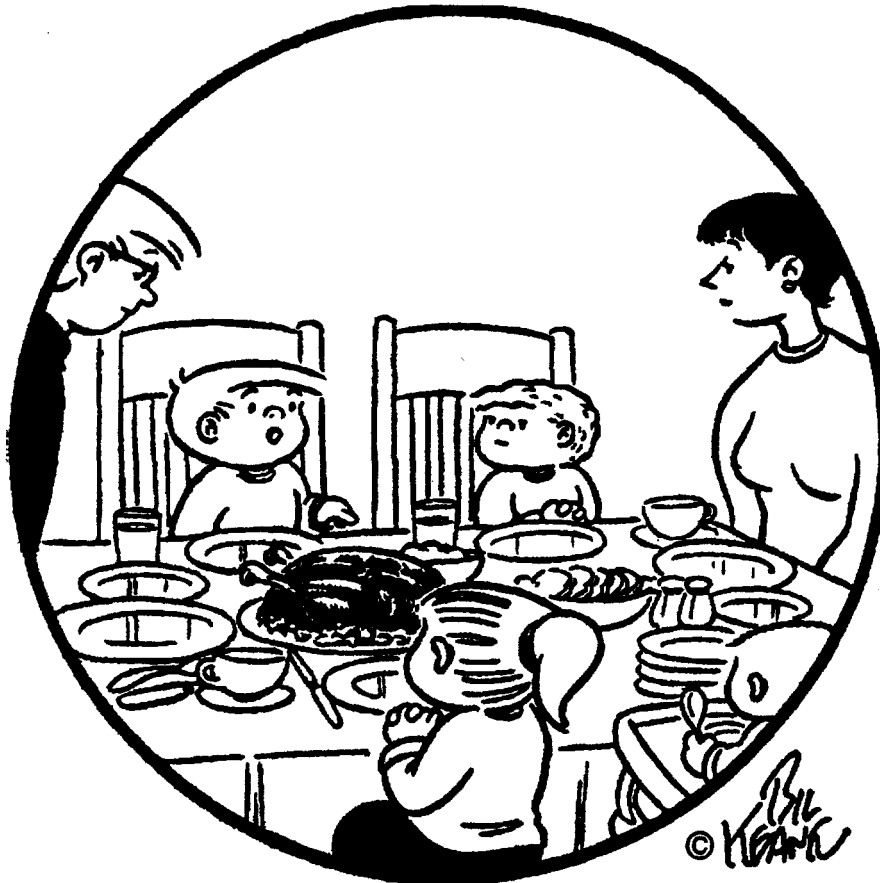
